# Winners with Every Draw and the Powerball Jackpot Climbs

## Saturday's Powerball Jackpot will be the 8th Largest on Record

**TRENTON (June 8, 2017)** – The Powerball jackpot is at record-setting levels. After 19 draws, the jackpot is now \$435 million, with a cash value of \$273.1 million, making it the 8<sup>th</sup> largest in the game's history. A New Jersey Lottery ticket brought home a \$429.6 million win on May 7, 2016, when the Smith Family of Trenton claimed the prize. Perhaps this will be another stupendous jackpot win for New Jersey.

Powerball is always lucky for New Jersey players. Each draw is an opportunity to win the jackpot prize and also any of the hundreds of thousands of lower-tier prizes. Since this roll began on April 5, there have been two \$1 million New Jersey Lottery prizewinners and 18 \$50,000 prizewinners. All total, New Jersey players have won more than \$7 million during these 19 draws. Here are some winner stories of prior Powerball drawings.



Joe Shafto Jr., \$50,000 Powerball Winner

The Feb. 18 Powerball drawing created one new millionaire and four \$50,000 prizewinners in New Jersey. Joseph Shafto Jr. of Brick was one of the \$50,000 prize claimants. He typically wagers a few dollars playing Mega Millions and Powerball. Shafto bought his \$2 single-board Quick Pick Powerball ticket on the Thursday before the drawing. That Saturday, his fiancée and her mother discussed Shafto's hopeful lottery ticket purchase over lunch, with a wink and a smile about his chances of winning. Shafto

checked his ticket on Sunday, realized that he had won \$50,000 and knew that it was his turn to smile. Shafto plans to use this money to pay off some bills and to provide tuition funds. His lucky retailer is Wine World, 2085 Route 88 in Brick.

"The Lucky Six" were also big winners from the Feb. 18 Powerball drawing. Chris Nocito of Palmyra, Randy Klaiss of So. Harrison, Charles Smith 3<sup>rd</sup> of Cinnaminson, Bob

"Congratulations to all of the lottery players who purchased winning tickets and to the retailers that sold them," said Carole Hedinger, New Jersey Lottery executive director. "I'd like to remind players to purchase their Powerball tickets with a winning attitude and add Power Play to the ticket purchase. Power Play doubles the second prize from one million dollars to two million dollars and multiplies all of the seven lower prize sets available in the game by the number drawn that evening. The jackpot prize is not multiplied."
