Two Jersey Cash 5 Tickets Split \$66,724 Jackpot in Hudson County

- Hudson County: S & A Stationary & Gift Shop, 140 Ocean Ave., Jersey City.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger said, "We are thrilled that the winning jackpot tickets were sold at Liquor House Inc. and S & A Stationary & Gift Shop, The retailers will receive a bonus check for \$2,000 for each winning ticket sold. Overnight, they have become two more 'lucky locations' for the very fortunate lottery winners."

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 228,705 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 47 ticketholders won \$425 each and 6 others won \$850 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn 1,288 ticketholders won \$16 each and 235 others won \$32 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 2,827 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
