One Jersey Cash 5 Ticket Wins \$158,293 Jackpot in Camden County

TRENTON (July 17, 2017) – One lucky ticket matched all five numbers drawn winning the \$158,293 Jersey Cash 5 jackpot from the Saturday, July 15 drawing. The winning numbers were: 07, 09, 15, 19 and 29 and the XTRA number was: 03. The lucky retailer that sold the winning ticket is One Stop Food Mart, 103 N.E. Atlantic Ave., Magnolia in Camden County.

Executive Director Carole Hedinger said, "We are thrilled that the winning jackpot ticket was sold One Stop Food Mart. The retailer will receive a bonus check for \$2,000 for selling the winning ticket. Overnight, they have become one more 'lucky location' for the very fortunate lottery winner."

Executive Director Carole Hedinger announced that there were 289,931 tickets purchased for the drawing. By adding XTRA, for an additional \$1.00 per play, winners are able to multiply their non-jackpot prizes by the XTRA number drawn. For correctly matching four of the five numbers drawn, 102 ticketholders won \$244 each and 15 others won \$732 each with the addition of XTRA. Moreover, for correctly matching three of the five numbers drawn, 2,668 ticketholders won \$10 each and 459 others won \$30 each with the addition of XTRA. Lastly, 4,392 ticketholders each won \$2 for correctly matching two of the five numbers drawn with the addition of XTRA on their purchase.
