\$372 Million Jackpot Won in Ohio

Thousands of New Jersey Players Win Prizes

TRENTON (Dec. 18, 2019) – New Jersey Lottery Acting Executive Director James Carey announced that an Ohio State Lottery ticketholder won the Mega Millions jackpot from the Tuesday, Dec. 17 drawing winning the \$372 million jackpot. The **winning numbers** for the **Tuesday, Dec. 17** drawing were: **22, 30, 53, 55 and 56**. The Gold **Mega Ball** was **16**, and the **Megaplier Multiplier** was **02**. One New Jersey player won \$10,000 for matching four of the five white balls drawn and the Gold Mega Ball. That ticket was sold at Lucky Stop, 499 Essex St., Hackensack in Bergen County.

In addition, 35 other players matched four of the five white balls drawn making each ticket worth \$500. Three of those tickets were purchased with the Megaplier option, multiplying the prize to \$1,000. Moreover, 53,021 other New Jersey players took home \$198,424 in prizes ranging from \$2 to \$400, according to Carey.

The next drawing will be held Friday, Dec. 20, at 11:00 pm. All New Jersey Lottery Mega Millions tickets must be purchased before 10:45 pm to participate in the drawing. Mega Millions tickets cost just two dollars; by adding the Megaplier option for an extra dollar per play, players can increase their non-jackpot winnings up to five times. Mega Millions tickets are sold in 46 participating jurisdictions. Drawings are held on Tuesdays and Fridays.
